**Field Trip:** K.C. Chiefs training camp

**Location:** Missouri Western State University, St. Joseph, MO

**Date & Time:** Sunday, August 15th at 1:00 PM

This trip will be a great opportunity for **sports photography**. The way the Chiefs have laid out the tandem practice fields, we should get some great photography from multiple angles and locations.

We'll meet at the Chief's team store at **1:00 PM**. Practice starts at **1:50 PM**. This should provide ample time to find locations from which we can begin shooting. (see maps on page 4)

For those of you who have never visited a training camp, the team normally breaks up into smaller groups and practices on different parts of the fields, so regardless of where you start you should have some excellent opportunities for photographs.

If you have a **telephoto lens** be sure to bring it, although you can get good results with a medium and wide-angle lens. I would also suggest a monopod if available, but it is not a necessity.

On the chief's website they have a list of items that are not allowed at chiefs training camp two of those items are professional cameras and lenses. I contacted the Chiefs about this and received an email back from the Chiefs public relations department indicating that our group was welcome to come to the chief's practice. I will make copies of this e-mail from the chiefs and hand out when we meet at the Chiefs training camp just in case you are questioned about your equipment.

The only piece of equipment that The Chiefs requested that we **do not use is tripods**, due to the crowds they feel it would be a safety hazard, monopods are acceptable.

Video recording of Chiefs practices are not permitted, please **no video** cameras.
