A life-long Kansas resident and avid collector of contemporary art. Dr. Meeker is widely published in academic and professional journals; his article "The Arts as Economic Development" was published in the January 2004 issue of *Bank News*. Dr. Meeker is active in his community and currently serves as the mayor of Lake Quivira, the president of the Johnson County Museum, chairman of the Johnson County Public Art Commission, a member of the Kansas-Missouri Metropolitan Culture Commission, and a member of the Johnson County's Citizens Visioning Committee. He is also a past president of the Arts Council of Johnson County and the Kansas City Jewish Museum of Contemporary Art.

A New Member Benefit - Based on our excellent program a few months back that dealt with sensor cleaning and dust removal the club has purchased a 7x Sensor Loupe (from Visible Dust) and a Giottos Rocket Blower. These

will be available, before meetings, from approx 6 to 6:30, for members use. Members can use the loupe to inspect their own camera sensor and, if needed, use the blower to try and dislodge any dust. While this will certainly not be the same as a



full (wet) sensor cleaning it is a very good first step and is often all that's needed. It will also serve as a good way for anyone to check their sensor to know when it is time to take/send your camera in for a more thorough cleaning. The planning committee thought this would be an excellent "value add" for the club and we hope you all agree and will make good use of it.

Squaw Creek Field Trip

When: Saturday, November 20 @ 7:30 AM

Where: Squaw Creek National Wildlife Refuge

We will meet at the observation deck inside the park. Right after you turn lift on Kovington Rd you'll see a parking area and



the observation deck.

The main objective of this trip will be to photograph bald eagles and migratory birds so bring your long lens. I would also recommend that you bring a medium and wide angle lens for other photo opportunities that might present themselves.

Some other equipment you may find useful is a tripod, polarizing and graduated neutral density filters, cable release or remote control for your camera and a bean bag for that quick shot out of the window.

We will be next to water the entire trip so please dress warmly.
