Monthly Member Photo Slideshow

Each meeting we have a slideshow of photos submitted by members. We hope that most members will submit images.

- Up to 5 images per member will keep the time interesting and stimulating. Note that the images you submit will also be posted on the Digital Dimensions website.
- Be prepared to share some of your technical data. You need not include all your metadata but be prepared to mention aperture, shutter speed, lens, and why you feel the image has impact and is enjoyable to you.
- When preparing your images please re-size them so they are at least 1024 pixels on the short side. This will allow them to fill the screen so they look better.
- Email your images to ddkclideshow@gmail.com or you may give them to Andrew (JPEG format) on a disk or flash drive at the meeting before 6:20pm. If you choose to bring your images please put them in a folder with your name on it to allow for easier organization of the slide show.

You are also encouraged to bring hard copies of your photos to share before and after the meeting at a table in the foyer.
