HDR via Photomatix

If you have ever photographed a high contrast scene you know that even the best exposure gives you blown out highlights, or flat shadows, or both. The solution is High Dynamic Range (HDR) processing. Take multiple photographs at varying exposure levels. Merge the photos into an HDR image and adjust the settings to get the look you want. Photomatix is photographic software developed by HDRsoft for Mac OS X and Microsoft Windows and primarily designed to make the process of merging multiple photographs into high dynamic range images and then locally tone-mapping them back to LDR images, easier and more streamlined. Andrew McDonald will introduce us to Photomatix and take us through the steps to create images you have only dreamed of.
